

# Water Conservation



## TIPS



Don't leave the water running while washing your face, shaving, or brushing your teeth.

With water running you use approximately:

2 gallons during teeth brushing

3-5 gallons while shaving



Take a shower rather than a bath.

A 5 minute shower uses approximately 20 gallons of water (approx. 5 gallons per minute).

A full bath tub uses approximately 36 gallons.



Check your faucets, pipes, and toilets for leaks.

A running toilet can use 1 gallon per hour.

A leaking faucet can use 9 gallons a day.



Install water savings showerheads and ultra-low flush toilets.

A low flow shower head uses approximately 2 gallons per minute versus a conventional shower head using between 3 to 4 gallons per minute.



Water off on cool, rainy, and windy days.

Evaporation is your lawn early in the morning .

Shut irrigation minimal in the morning.
