General Duties

Litter pick up
Raking
Weeding, mowing, and trimming
Plant and water flowers

Replace & maintain park equipment
Adding new park equipment
Contribute and install grass, plants and other landscaping material
Fertilize or spray plants for pests (if using restricted chemicals, participants must be licensed by the
State of Minnesota.)
Cleaning picnic tables and sweeping shelters

Guidelines

- The group must discuss and inform the Park and Recreation Committee Chairman of any changes prior to making them.
- All duties done should benefit the majority of the park users.
- To ensure safety, all duties done should be done during daylight hours.
- The group will notify the Perham Public Works Director of any vandalism or potential safety hazards.
