A leading cause of gas system damage is failure to call 8-1-1

\* Gopher State One Call is a free statewide service that allows utilities to locate any buried facilities they own before you start digging. They can be contacted at (800) 252-1166 or by dialing 8-1-1

\* Just call two (2) business days before digging and provide the requested information

\* **Remember to Call—It's free**

## Suspect a Gas Leak?

### Act Immediately!

## SMELL, HEAR, SEE

Learn to recognize the warning signs of a natural gas leak:

- ⇒ **Smell:** Natural Gas itself is odorless, but an odorant is added to help detect a leak, it is described as smelling like rotten eggs or sulfur.
- ⇒ **Hear:** Leaking natural gas may produce a hissing or blowing sound.
- ⇒ **See:** A potential leak might also cause bubbling in puddles or blowing dirt/dust, or dead grass and plants for no apparent reason.



⇒ **Evacuate the area**—travel upwind to escape any potentially dangerous accumulation of gas and do not reenter until

told it's safe to do so.

- ⇒ **Call Perham Natural Gas or 9-1-1** from a safe location, such as a neighbor's house—NOT the building or area where you smell the gas.
- ⇒ **DO NOT:** light a match, operate light switches, appliances, engines, cell phones, or any other potential sources of ignition.
- ⇒ **Warn others** to stay out of the area until help arrives.

## How to Recognize Gas Pipelines

Underground natural gas transmission pipelines are indicated by special markers, as seen below. All pipeline markers provide the company's name, type of product carried by the pipeline, and the emergency contact number.

Even if a marker is present, it does not follow a pipeline's exact path or provide buried depth. It is still very important to **call Gopher State One Call at 8-1-1** before digging.
